

STUDENT NEIGHBORHOOD ACCESS PROGRAM

SCHOOL OVERVIEW

Mountain West Montessori Academy is located at 4125 West Foxview Drive in South Jordan. The campus will serve approximately 502 students in grades K-9.

Most students will arrive and depart in carpools or guardian vehicles. Patrons are asked to follow the school's designated Drop Off and Pick Up procedures to ensure student safety and the efficiency of traffic flow through the area.

It is estimated an average of 75 students will walk or bike to and from school. Students that walk or bike are encouraged to follow the below maps outlined safe walking routes and always use the sidewalk.

TRAVELING FROM THE NORTHEAST

Students traveling from the northeast area should travel south on 4000 W. using stoplights to cross at the appropriate and safe time. Students should then travel west on Foxview Drive until they reach the crosswalk to cross to the south side of Foxview Drive.

TRAVELING FROM THE SOUTHEAST

Students traveling from the southeast area should travel north on 4000 W. using all sidewalks until they reach Foxview Drive. Students should then turn west on Foxview Drive until they reach the school.

TRAVELING FROM THE WEST

Students traveling from the west should travel east until they reach one of the main residential roads (11430 S., 11595 S., and Harvest Moon Drive). Students should then travel east on the main residential road until they reach Country Crossing Drive and follow it to Foxview Drive.

It is not recommended that students east of Bangerter Highway, south of 11800 S., and north of Daybreak Parkway walk or bike to school.

Minus the safe traveling routes outlined above, the school advises against students walking or bilking to and from school, especially during heavy traffic periods on the roadway. The school is located near a high-volume, high-speed roadway which is not recommended for pedestrian or bicycle transportation.

Parents and students who decide to walk or bike to and from school should follow the safest routes possible using sidewalks or crosswalks to reach nearby residential neighborhoods. Parents who choose to allow their students to walk or bike to school are encouraged to travel these routes with their children to determine the safest route possible.

Parents who choose to allow their students to walk or bike to and from school will assume responsibility for all risks involved. Travelers should obey all traffic lights, laws, signs, and signals and cross carefully and legally to enter and exit school grounds.

Note that the speed limit along Foxview Drive is 25 mph around the school and the area is not a designated School Zone. We ask that parents not park in this area to increase parking lot visibility and student safety.

These routes are for the immediate area around Mountain West Montessori Academy and are not exhaustive. Please contact the school for additional information regarding safe traveling routes.

AREA IMPROVEMENT RECOMMENDATIONS

To increase student safety, as well as walking and biking access to the school facilities for students residing in the neighboring residential areas, the following items are considerations the school would propose as area improvements.

- Speed Limits
 - Post reduced speed School Zone speed limit signs (20 mph) along Foxview Drive with flashing signs.
- Crosswalks and Crossing Guards
 - Place a crosswalk across Foxview Drive at the northwest corner of the school property. It is recommended that this crosswalk have a crossing guard and flags for student use.
 - Place a crosswalk at the intersection of Foxview Drive and Country Crossing
 Drive to provide access to the residential neighborhood west of Foxview Drive.
 It is recommended that this crosswalk have a crossing guard and flags for
 student use.
- Traffic Management

• Create a No Parking zone with signs and red curbs along the north and south sides of Foxview Drive in the proximity of the school and for thirty (30) feet on either side of the exits.


Please note, the school does not oversee area improvements and only the local government can determine which recommendations to undergo.
